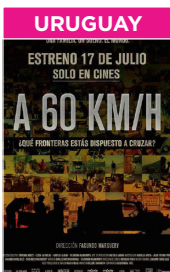
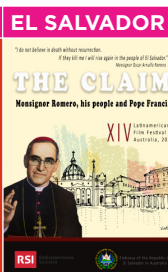

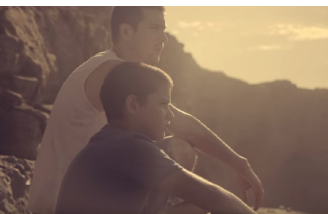
Victoria receives an unexpected visit. Her daughter Sara, with whom she has not spoken for some time, asks

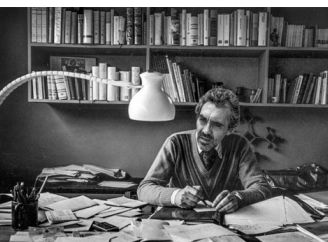

Frustrated and under the excesses of alcohol and sex, his life becomes chaotic. With no little effort he returns to build his band and triumphs. The debaucheries of other times result in a severe liver crisis that puts him on the verge of death, the doctor definitively prohibiting alcohol. Against all odds it recovers and reappears in the main cabaret and salons of Cuba. One night, in the middle of a dance, confident by the apparent good health and...

A secret in the box

A SECRET IN THE BOX explores the life and works of Marcelo Chiriboga (1933-1990), an internationally known Ecuadorian writer and member

of the “boom” generation, who remains unknown in his country. Through multiple voices and varied archival footage, the film reconstructs the puzzle of Chiriboga and erases the limits between reality and fiction.

From his early youth marked by the Ecuador-Peru War and political compromise, up to prolonged exile in East Berlin and the publication of the novel THE IMAGINARY LINE (1968), which would grant him worldwide fame and censorship in his own country, the film explores the complex relationships between history and art, art and life.

Monsignor Oscar Arnulfo Romero, Archbishop of San Salvador, was assassinated in 1980 by death squads. Pope

Francis, upon his arrival in 2013, initiated the process of his canonization, a stormy one that had divided the ecclesiastical institutions. The importance of Romero transcends that of El Salvador. In his honour, United Nations celebrates every 24th of March as the International Day for the Right to the Truth Concerning Gross Human Rights Violations and for the Dignity of Victims.



GUATEMALA

September, a Silent Cry

In the 1980s, Guatemala suffered a terrorist attack. The memory of the attack is the starting point of this movie.

Teresa loses her mother after

the explosion. She survives, but loses her ability to hear. Joshua will have to take up the role of both father and mother with a deaf girl whose surroundings are not fit for her condition. The little girl will be forced to leave school because (ironically) she failed her music class. Her father will become her safe haven again. But over the years Teresa grows up, she is almost a woman and starts to seek her own path by bursting the overprotected paternal bubble. The atmosphere of the film is like darkness before dawn: It is that moment in life in which, although it seems that everything is going wrong, you do not know what you can find just around the corner.

Marlene wants to find out the truth about his grandfather and, in spite of the resistance of José, he decides to embark on a trip with her to discover the truth and unearth memories and secrets.

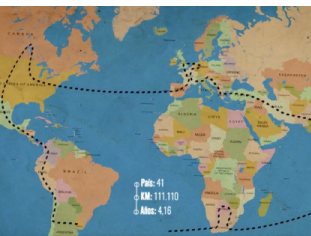
This movie is inspired by real events. Set in the early twentieth century, it tells the story of Enrique Aet, a young Peruvian

engineer who seeks to connect the Amazon rainforest with the rest of Peru. First, Aet is involved in the construction of roads and bridges over the rivers of the Amazon. With the fall of a bridge, he has an accident and must return to Lima. There, he will meet Doris, a young bourgeois with whom he will initiate a loving relationship. Then he embarks to Europe and becomes a telegraph connoisseur. When he returns to Peru, he struggles to bring to his country the progress that he learned of in the Old Continent.

To the south of the Guárico state in Venezuela is a little-known town called Corozopando.

Gregorio, the mayor, has always wanted to bring world recognition to his tiny town. Although this aspiration seems farfetched, one night the prophecy of a spirit magically convinces both Gregorio and the rest of the inhabitants to place their hopes in a child named Rubén Darío, imposing on him the responsibility of bringing fame to the town, and calling him the 'DiCaprio of Corozopando.' For his part, Rubén innocently assumes this responsibility and he insists on doing everything possible to bring the small and remote community fame and fortune. An eccentric, slightly absurdist, and utterly absorbing offbeat tale of the sometimes hilarious limits of local 'celebrity,' and the desire to be recognized in that big world beyond.
